### Art Clay

### PE

#### Jumping

Practise your jumping techniques. How far can you jump? Can you show how you have improved this half term, measuring your jumps and recording them.

#### Gymnastics

Can you demonstrate the different rolls and movements we have learnt in an interesting way. How many different ways can you link your movements?

### Science - Materials

#### Knowledge

Recycling- what materials can be recycled? Help your parents with recycling. What can we do to help recycle more? Create a poster to show what can be recycled.

#### Investigations

Can you find out what material can keep a drink warm? Work with an adult to plan and carry out an investigation. We can't wait to see your results.

### RE- Who is Jewish and how do they live?

Do you have special objects at home? Draw them or take a photo and tell us why.

Find out about the special objects used by Jews during Shabbat. Can you draw and label them?

### Topic- Arctic

#### History

Find out about an explorer who visited the Arctic  
Why did he need to pack? How did he get there?

#### Geography

Label a map of the continents and oceans.  
You could decorate it in different colours/patterns/textiles.

### PSHE- Growing and changing

Create your own timeline from when you were born to you now.  
You might want to include photos and information about milestones (when you walked, any holidays, changes like moving house or a new family member).

Write about a fun surprise you were involved in.  
What was the event? How did you keep the fun secret? How did other people react?

### Computing - Computer systems and networks

What pieces of Information Technology do you have at home? How are they similar/different?  
Do you use them? How/what for?

Use technology to present a piece of homework for another subject.

### Maths- Money, division, fractions and shape

Practise dividing in to equal groups with items found in the home. What different ways can you share 4, 8, 12, 15, 18?  
Practise counting on in 2s, 5s and 10s.  
Practise reading the time using o'clock, half and quarter past/to.

### Music – I wanna play in a band

Instruments  
Make your own instrument. Can you play your instrument to a favourite song?

Find out about a popular band. Who are they? What songs are they known for? Do they play instruments?
