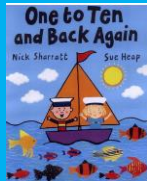


Mathematics

We start the year by refreshing place value understanding with numbers to 10. We will explore counting on from any given number, exploring one more and one less, as well as using the number line within our maths sessions. We will also use a range of stories to support our maths understanding.



PSHE Me and My Relationships.

Children will discuss classroom rules and why they are in place. They will then move on to recognising and exploring their feelings, who to speak to when they are upset and how to regulate their own emotions. Finally, students will identify the qualities of a good friend and how to resolve conflict situations through positive feedback and good listening

Literacy

Our first topic of the year will be 'Marvellous Me!' and to help us explore this we will start with reading 'Super Duper Me'. Using this as our class inspiration, the children will develop their use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Our second book will be 'Whiffy Wilson' which will link to our science topic. The children will complete an independent piece based on this story using the sentence writing skills we have been developing.

Science

Animals Including Humans - The Human Body and our Senses:

In this unit, children will learn about the human body, naming, drawing, and labelling basic body parts. They will engage in a variety of investigations using their senses as a guide to conduct their experiments. They will learn which body part is associated with which sense. Finally, they will finish the term looking at the seasons, starting with the Autumn.

Art

The focus for this half term will be all about drawing skills and self-portraits. We will study a local artist and use some of their techniques to help us.

P.E.

Ball skills: hands. We will be exploring ways which we can pass and stop and ball.

Team building: developing communication skills and partner trust.

Religious Education

Who is Muslim and how do they live? Part 1. We will explore the importance of the Shahadah to Muslims, as well as why Muslims have 99 names for Allah. We will finish at looking at the first of the five pillars in the Muslim faith.

Geography
