Use your knowledge of light, reflection and shadows to create a quiz. You should ask between 5 and 10 questions. Make sure you also make an answer sheet	Create some shadow puppets! Use card paper and ice lolly sticks to explore how opaque objects block out light and how shadows change depending on their distance from the light source.
